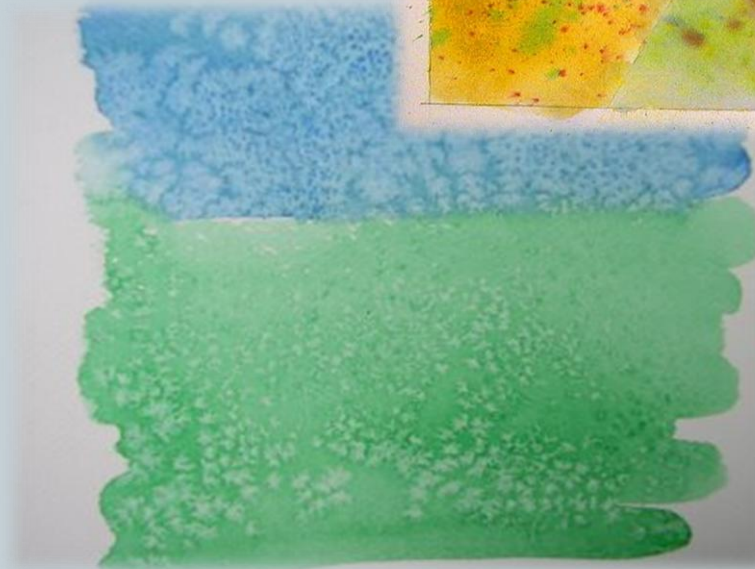
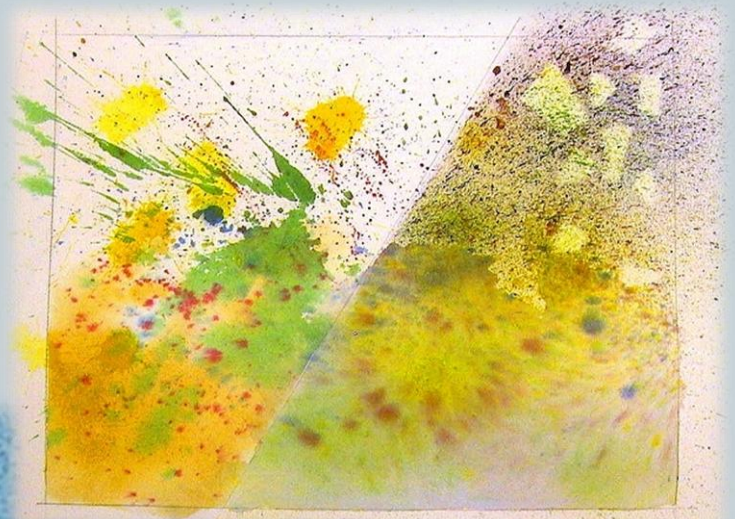

13. Sgraffito
