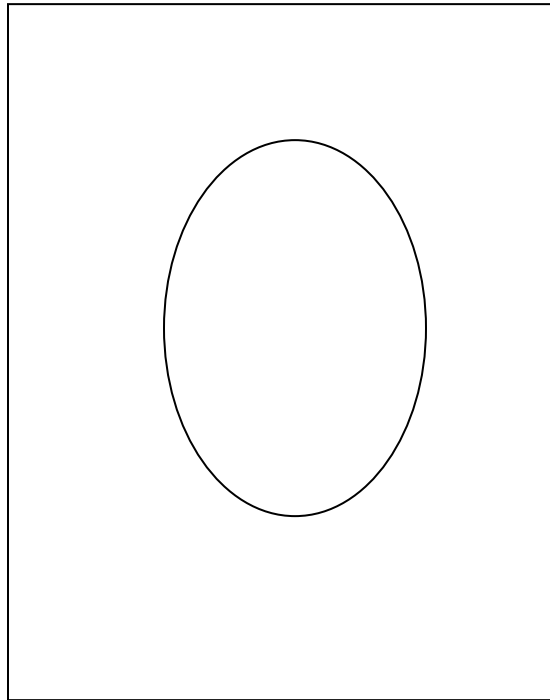


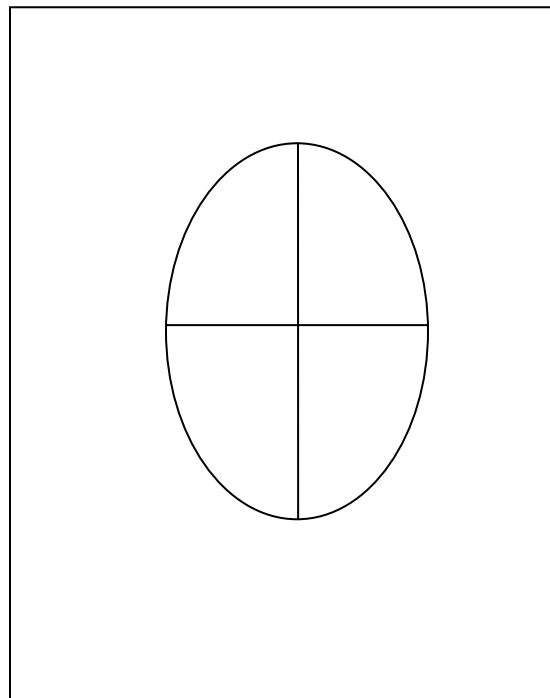
Self Portrait

Objective: To draw a portrait of yourself using proportional techniques shown below.

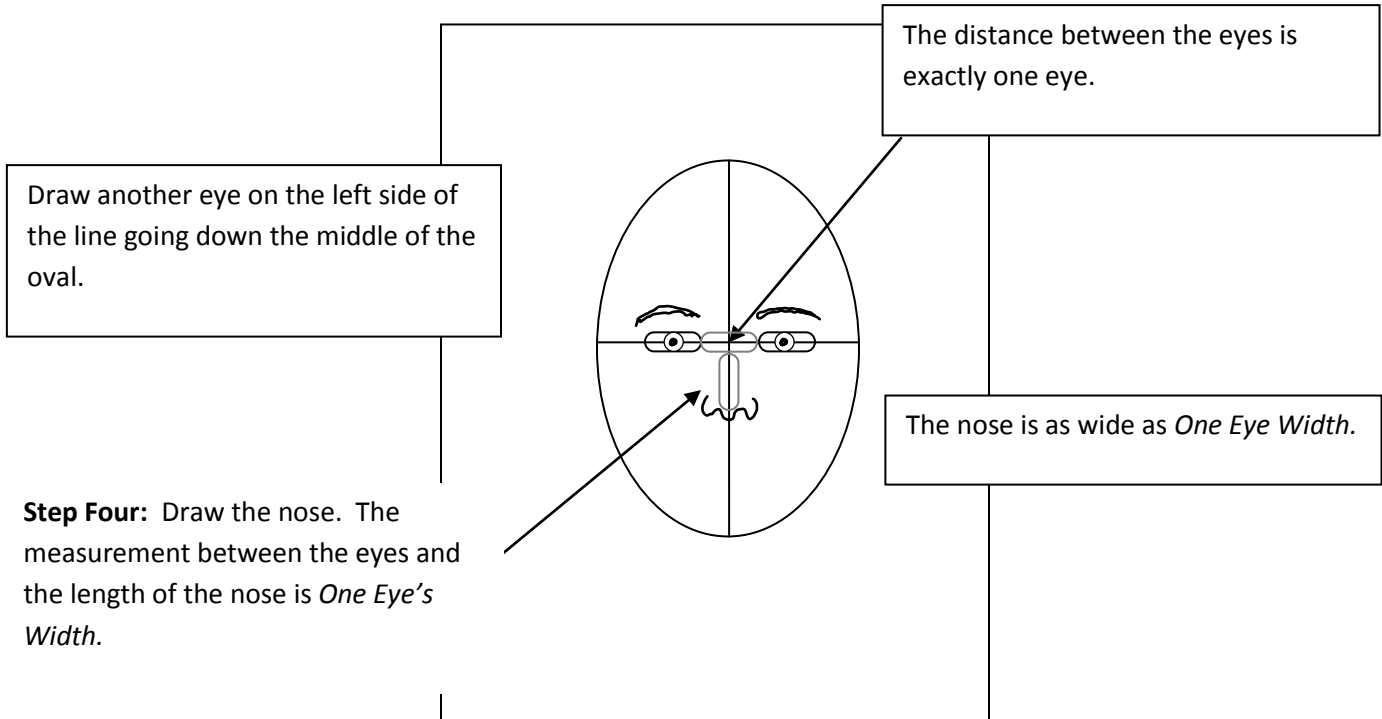
Step One: Draw an oval in the middle of your paper. Paper is placed vertically on your desk.



Step Two: Draw a horizontal and a vertical line down the middle of the oval and across the middle of the oval.

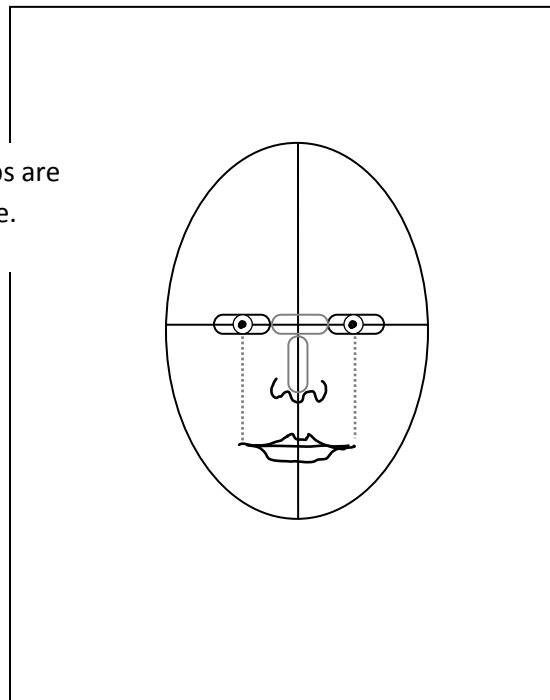


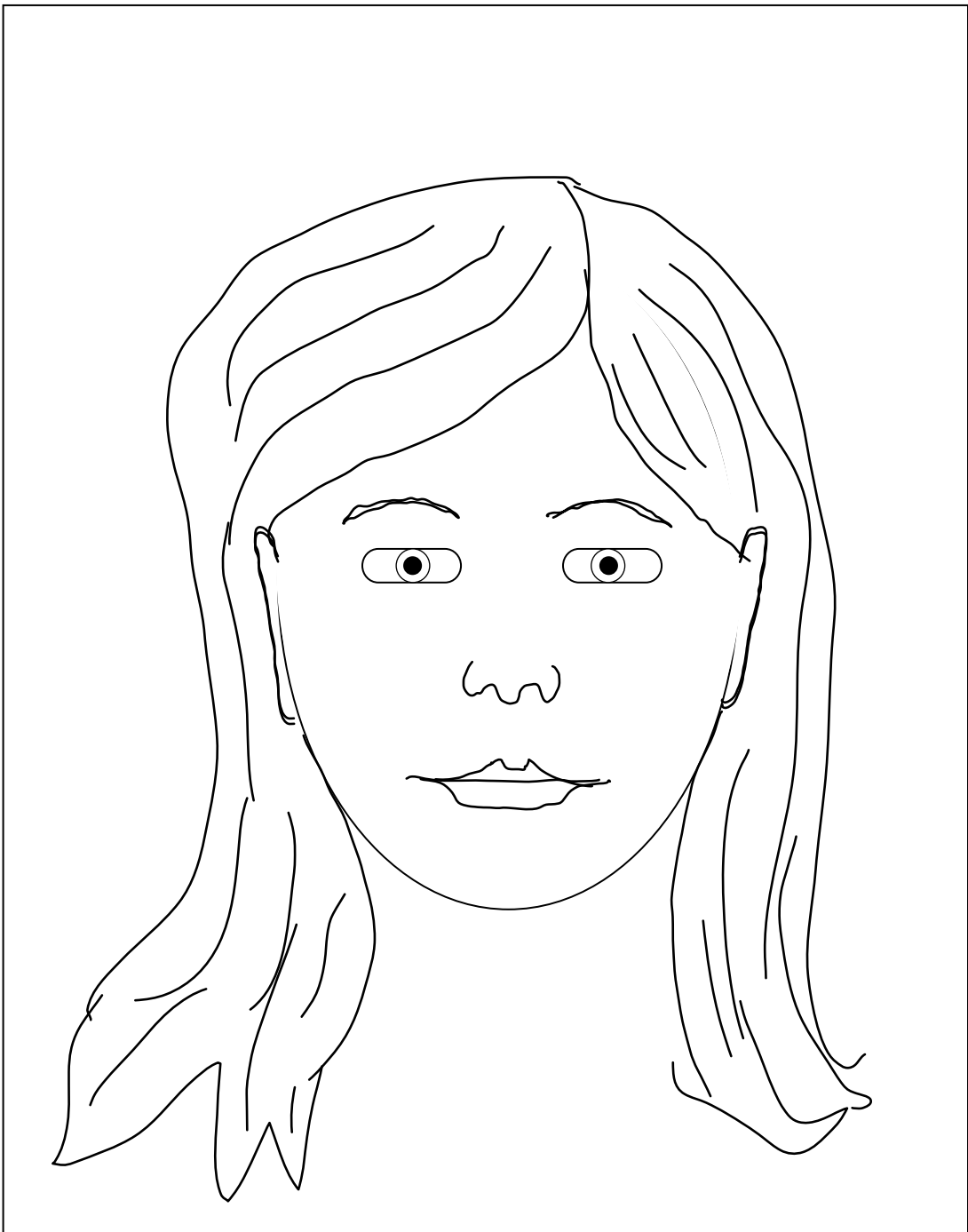
Step Three: Draw eyes (oval shape) on the right side of the line going down the middle. Draw eyebrows above each eye. See example.



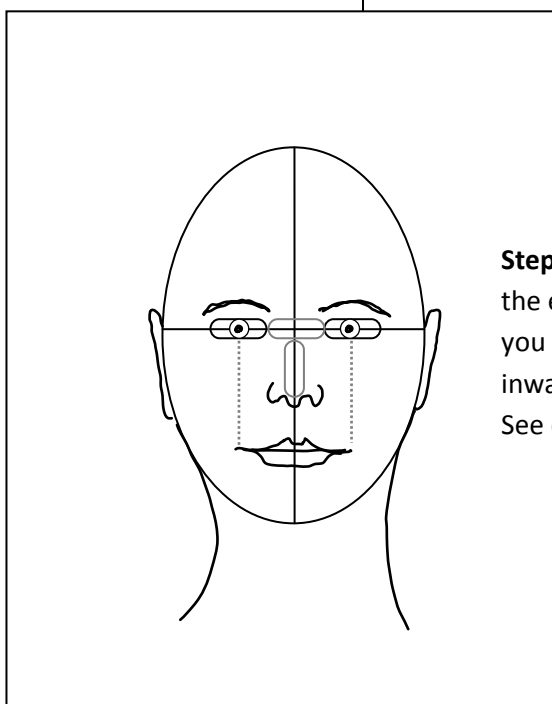
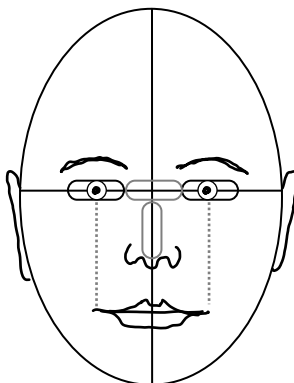
Step Four: Draw the nose. The measurement between the eyes and the length of the nose is *One Eye's Width*.

Step Five: Draw the lips. The lips are as wide as the center of each eye.





Step Six: Draw the ears. The ears are as high as the eyebrows and as low as the nose. Draw the ears as thin letter C's – forwards for the left ear and backwards for the right ear.



Step Seven: Draw the neck. Start at the ears and follow the chin line until you get to the mouth and then curve inward and down and then back out. See example.

Step Eight: Draw the Hair. Make it fuller than the head it self. Draw lines indicating the way the hair falls.
